Countrylink trains to Canberra, Griffith and Melbourne

Frequency Guide

Service frequency is indicated by six numbers in a coloured box. Each number represents the number of services scheduled per hour.

The six numbers relate to times of the week thus:
 First row: - Monday to Friday
 Second row: - Saturdays
 Third row: - Sundays
 Left column: - Daytime
 Right column: - Evening

Note that typically there will be more frequent services on Monday to Friday peak hours.

12 per hour = 5 minute intervals
 10 per hour = 6 minute intervals
 8 per hour = 7 1/2 minute intervals
 6 per hour = 10 minute intervals

5 per hour = 12 minute intervals
 4 per hour = 15 minute intervals
 3 per hour = 20 minute intervals
 2 per hour = 30 minute intervals

Journey duration is illustrated by clockfaces. The shaded area shows the journey duration. Trains are measured from Central Station (Cumberland line from Blacktown). Ferries are timed from Circular Quay or local terminus.
